<p><b>Who Reports?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Medical malpractice payers</li> <li>▪ State health care practitioner licensing and certification authorities (including medical and dental boards)</li> <li>▪ Hospitals</li> <li>▪ Other health care entities with formal peer review (HMOs, group practices, managed care organizations)</li> <li>▪ Professional societies with formal peer review</li> <li>▪ State entity licensing and certification authorities</li> <li>▪ Peer review organizations</li> <li>▪ Private accreditation organizations</li> <li>▪ DEA</li> <li>▪ HHS OIG</li> </ul> <p><b>What Information is Available?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Medical malpractice payments (all health care practitioners)</li> <li>▪ Any adverse licensure actions (all practitioners or entities) --revocation, reprimand, censure, suspension, probation --any dismissal or closure of the proceedings by reason of the practitioner or entity surrendering the license or leaving the State or jurisdiction --any other loss of license</li> <li>▪ Adverse clinical privileging actions</li> <li>▪ Adverse professional society membership actions</li> <li>▪ Any negative action or finding by a State licensing or certification authority</li> <li>▪ Peer review organization negative actions or finding against health care practitioners</li> <li>▪ Private accreditation organization negative actions or findings against health entities</li> <li>▪ Adverse Actions against DEA Certification</li> <li>▪ Medicare/Medicaid Exclusions</li> </ul> <p><b>Who Can Query?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Hospitals</li> <li>▪ Other health care entities, with formal peer review</li> <li>▪ Professional societies with formal peer review</li> <li>▪ State health care practitioner licensing and certification authorities (including medical and dental boards)</li> <li>▪ State entity licensing and certification authorities*</li> <li>▪ Agencies or contractors administering Federal health care programs*</li> <li>▪ State agencies administering State health care programs*</li> <li>▪ State Medicaid Fraud Units*</li> <li>▪ U.S. Comptroller General*</li> <li>▪ U.S. Attorney General and other law enforcement*</li> <li>▪ Health care practitioners (self query)</li> <li>▪ Plaintiff's attorney/<i>pro se</i> plaintiffs (under limited circumstances)**</li> <li>▪ Quality Improvement Organizations*</li> <li>▪ Researchers (statistical data only)</li> </ul> <p>* Eligible to receive only those reports authorized by section 1921.  ** Eligible to receive only those reports authorized by HCQIA.</p>	<p><b>Who Reports?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Federal and State Government Agencies</li> <li>▪ Health Plans</li> </ul> <p><b>What Information is Available?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Licensing and certification actions (practitioners, providers, and suppliers) revocation, reprimand, suspension (including length), censure, probation, voluntary surrender, any other negative action or finding by a Federal or State licensing or certification agency that is publicly available information</li> <li>▪ Health care-related civil judgments (practitioners, providers, and suppliers)</li> <li>▪ Health care-related criminal convictions (practitioners, providers and suppliers)</li> <li>▪ Exclusions from Federal or State health care programs (practitioners, providers, and suppliers)</li> <li>▪ Other adjudicated actions or decisions (practitioners, providers, and suppliers)</li> </ul> <p><b>Who Can Query?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Federal and State Government Agencies</li> <li>▪ Health Plans</li> <li>▪ Health care practitioners/providers/suppliers (self-query)</li> <li>▪ Researchers (statistical data only)</li> </ul>
